

## Milestones: Emergence of Self and Development of Self-Concept

(Berk, 2003, p. 447)

Age	Milestones
1-2 yrs.	Self-recognition becomes well-established.
	Categorical self develops.
3-5 yrs.	Remembered self, in the form of a life story, develops.
	Desire theory of mind expands into a belief-desire theory, as indicated by mastery of false-belief tasks.
	Self-concept emphasizes observable characteristics and typical emotions and attitudes.
6-10 yrs.	Self-concept emphasizes personality traits and includes both positive and negative attributes.
	Social comparisons among multiple individuals appear.
11 yrsadulthood	Self-concept includes higher-order, abstract descriptors that unify separate traits (e.g., "smart" and "talented" into "intelligent).
	Traits making up self-concept are combined into an organized system.
